Eligible Applicants: Persons with spinal cord injuries.

The David Lytle Memorial Foundation has four grant cycles per year. Dates that Applications for Assistance requests must be received in the office are January 1 (first quarter grant cycle), April 1 (second quarter grant cycle), July 1 (third quarter grant cycle) and October 1 (fourth quarter grant cycle). If these dates fall on a holiday or a weekend, proposal requests are due on the next business day. Decisions and disbursements of funds for proposal requests are made approximately three months from the due date.
